Sealed tenders are hereby invited on behalf of the Vice-Chairman, State Health Society, Goa by the National Programme for Control of Blindness, Directorate of Health Services, Panaji - Goa for purchase of Spectacles.

The Tender documents with Terms & Conditions can be purchased from National Programme for Control of Blindness, Directorate of Health Services, Panaji on payment of Rs. 1,500/- in cash (Rupees One Thousand Five Hundred Only) (non refundable).

The Tender Terms and Conditions are also available on website www.nhmgoa.gov.in. The same can be downloaded for the purpose. However, the tender cost of Rs. 1,500/- should be sent along with Tender by Demand Draft drawn in favour of The National Trachoma and Blindness Control Programme, Panaji – Goa.

The sale of Tender sets will commence from **04/05/2017** during office hours and will be available for sale **up to 11/05/2017** **till 5.00 p.m.**

The last date for receiving Tender document is **12/05/2017** **up to 12:00 p.m.** and the Tenders will be opened on the same day i.e. **12/05/2017** **at 3.00 p.m.** in the seminar Room of DHS.

TENDER NOTICE

TECHNICAL BID AND FINANCIAL BID TO BE SENT IN SEPARATE ENVELOPES

1. **Sealed tenders** are invited by the Vice-Chairman, State Health Society c/o DHS, Panaji, Goa **up to 12/05/2015 at 12:00 p.m.** for supply of Spectacles. The details of which are described in Annexure I & Annexure II.
2. Small Scale Industrial Units registered under Directorate of Industries & Mines, Panaji should produce a copy of registration for exemption from the deposit and they are entitled for price preference up to 15%. The National Small Industries Corporation Ltd, a Government of India undertaking is also entitled for the said benefits in the terms of the Government of India, Ministry of Industry (Department of Industrial Development) New Delhi letter No. SSI (I) – (25) (2) dated 31.1.78. All other SSI units will be treated at par with other firms.
3. Sealed tender should be super scribed **Tender No. DHS/NPCB/SPECT-TENDER/2017-18/27 dated 02/05/2017**. Tender for supply of Spectacles, due on **12/05/2017 at 12:00p.m.** Tender should either be deposited in the tender Box kept in this office by Tendering Authority, or his authorized representative or sent by Registered Post A/D .The closing date will be up to **12/05/2017 at 12:00p.m.** Late tender i.e. tenders received after specified closing time will not be considered. Tender sent through courier should be dispatched so that it reaches this office before closing time and no explanation will be entertained for reasons such as delay in flight etc. The Technical Bid will be opened on **12/05/2017 at 3:00p.m.** in the presence of the tenderers or their representative if any, and members of the Common Purchase Committee.
4. The tender document duly completed in all respects should reach to this office **on or before 12/05/2017 by 12:00 p.m.** Non submission of tenders within the stipulated date and time will not be entertained.
 - i) The Cost of the Tender documents –Rs. 1,500/-
 - ii) EMD-2.5% of the cost of the items quoted.
 - iii) The Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) equivalent to 2.5% of the total cost of the supply is required to be sent along with the quotation. The deposit should be in the form of Demand Draft drawn on any Nationalized Bank in Goa issued in favour of The National Trachoma and Blindness Control Programme, Panaji-Goa.
 - iv) The Earnest Money Deposit of unsuccessful tenderers will be refunded once the tenders are decided or once the successful tenderer signs the agreement and furnishes security deposit. If the successful tenderer does not pay the security deposit and does not sign the contract within the time limit fixed by the Director of Health Services, the order will be treated as cancelled and Earnest money deposit forfeited in the favor of Government.
5. Tender which are not accompanied with the specified amount of EMD and not in conformity with the terms and conditions as well as specifications will be summarily rejected.
6. Tenders which are not accompanied by the following documents will not be considered.
 - a) Copy of Tin No. Certificate of the tenderer.
 - b) Certified copy of valid manufacturing license along with latest approved list of products in respect of drugs quoted, issued under Drugs and cosmetics Rules 1945.

- c) A certificate from State Drugs Controller that the Manufacturer is neither convicted nor prosecuted under the Drugs and cosmetics Act 1940 for manufacturing spurious drugs, adulterated or substandard drugs, which should not be more than one year old.
 - d) Valid Income Tax Clearance Certificate and Sales Tax Clearance Certificate should be produced along with the tender.
 - e) Certificate from the chartered Accountant/Drug Controller certifying that the Manufacturer has been manufacturing and marketing the products quoted for the preceding 3 years.
7. Canvassing in connection with quotations is strictly prohibited and any other quotation submitted by the party who resorts to canvassing will be liable for rejection.
 8. Overwriting and corrections are not accepted in the tender. However, if found unavoidable, such overwriting, correction shall be properly attested by the Competent Authority.
 9. The opening of the tender and recording the quoted rate in the presence of the supplier does not amount to acceptance of the quotation. The acceptance or rejection of the quotation depending upon their appropriation will be decided by the Competent Authority only on detailed scrutiny.
 10. The brochures containing details of item including make and standard along with companies profile and list of the clients to whom such devices are supplied may be enclosed.
 11. The supplier should have authorized dealer with registered office in the State of Goa.
 12. The rates quoted should be valid for atleast **24 months** from the date of acceptance of tender.
 13. If the item supplied are found to be sub-standard quality and not according to the specifications approved by this office, the same will be liable to be summarily rejected.
 14. In case of acceptance of tender, Security Deposit at 5% of total value of supply order should be deposited within 15 days from the date of issue of letter of acceptance of supply order in the form of bank guarantee from a nationalized bank. The period of Security Deposit will be for 2 years from the date of supply of the material.
 15. The complete supply is to be done within 20 days from the date of issue of detailed supply order. The quantities mentioned are indicative. The actual requirement may increase or decrease at the time of purchase.
 16. Late delivery charges – for every week of delay in supplying, installation, commissioning the compensation at minimum 0.5 percent of the value of the items remaining to be supplied after due date limited to maximum of 5% of the total cost shall be charged at the discretion of the Competent Authority.
 17. The parts/item under warranty should be replaced within 48 hrs.
 18. The successful tenderer have to enter into an agreement with the Department within 15 days of the supply order. The draft agreement shall be provided by the department.
 19. The tenderer should submit performance certificate that supplies are satisfactory, from any Government or Semi Government procurement agency, issued by the Director.

20. Liquidated damage of 10% of value of goods not supplied, will be imposed for the delay in supply order and the above period of delivery or non execution of the order either in part/full. Alternately, Director of Health Services reserve the right to make risk purchase, in case the successful tenderer fails to supply any of the items within the time limit specified in the order and difference in price will be recovered from the tenderer/contractor. The Director of Health Services reserves the right to waive the penalty/risk purchase in genuine and deserving cases.
21. The Vice Chairman, State Health Society (NHM), Directorate of Health Services, reserves the right to accept/ reject any tender in part or whole without assigning any reasons thereof. His decision on the dispute in any way will be final.
22. Any dispute or difference whatsoever arising between the parties, out of or relating to the conclusions, meaning and operation or effect of the agreement or the breach thereof shall be settled by Arbitrator in accordance to the Rules of Arbitration of the Indian Government of the Arbitration and the amount made in pursuance thereby shall be binding on the parties.
23. Samples of the items, packed & labelled separately should be produced along with the technical bid.
24. The details information of the product in the form of the brochure may be submitted along with the technical bid.
25. In the event of an order being placed with against the tender and failure to supply equipments in accordance with the terms and conditions by acceptance of tender or to replace any items rejected by this office or any person on his behalf within such frame as may be stipulated , the Vice Chairman, State Health Society (NHM), Directorate of Health Services, shall be entitled to purchase from elsewhere without notice to the tenderer on the account, such material from any other service and at such prices as the Competent Authority shall at the sole discretion think fit and if such prices shall exceed the rate set out in the schedule to acceptance of tender, the tenderer shall be responsible to pay the difference between the price at which such items have been purchased by this office and the price calculated at the rate set out in the schedule.
26. Bids without any of the above mentioned certificates/documents shall be summarily disqualified.

QUANTITY-1000 NOS.

Following are the minimum requirements. Products offered must meet these parameters herein.

Frame Material: - Full frame fibre (side multi colours), Fronts of the frame should be foldable(rough and tough), with experiment in front of purchase committee, Side of the frame should be stretchable, Side can be spring or without spring.

Frame Size: - For children aged 5 to 18 years.

Lens: - English white glass or CR 39 lens.

Powers: - Equal to or greater than +/-0.75 Diopter
Spherical & or Cylindrical power or as per prescriptions.
