The prices should include the prices of delivery and installation of the goods/appliances. Prices to be quoted for individual item separately. The total cost should include the taxes, duties, packing and forwarding, labour charges, insurance, delivery, installation and ex-works if any.

Valid Income Tax Clearance Certificate and Sales Tax Clearance Certificate should be produced along with the quotation.

Canvassing in connection with quotations is strictly prohibited and any other quotation submitted by the party who resorts to canvassing will be liable for rejection.

Overwriting and corrections are not accepted in the complete quotation. However, if found unavoidable, such overwriting, correction should be properly attested by the Competent Authority. Quotation should mention proper date with proper reference number. If found incorrect will be liable for rejection.

The opening of the quotation and recording the quoted rate in the presence of the supplier does not amount to acceptance of the quotation. The acceptance or rejection of the quotation depending upon their appropriation and will be decided by the Competent Authority only on detailed scrutiny.

The supplier should clearly indicate the warranty. An assurance for providing this should be submitted. The brochures containing details of item including make and standard along with Companies profile and list of the clients to whom such devices are supplied may be enclosed.

The supplier should be authorized dealer with registered office in the State of Goa.

The product should have a shelf life of at least 2 years from the time of receipt of product by the customer. Manufacturer should declare the same in originals on the letterhead. The bidder shall submit the same at the time of bid opening.

The rates quoted should be valid for at least Six months from the date of acceptance of tender/quotation.

If the item supplied are found to be sub-standard quality and not according to the specifications approved by this office, the same shall be liable to be summarily rejected.

The complete supply is to be done within 15 days from the date of issue of detailed supply order. The quantities mentioned are indicative. The actual requirement may increase or decrease at the time of purchase.

<u>Late delivery charges</u> — For every week of delay in supplying, installation, commissioning, the compensation at minimum 0.5 percent of the value of the items remaining to be supplied after due date limited to maximum of 5% of the total cost shall be charged at the discretion of the Competent Authority.

The parts/item under warranty should be replaced within 48 hrs.

The successful quotationer has to enter into an agreement with the Department within seven days of the supply order.

The Chief Medical Officer TB Control Programme Panaji reserves the right to accept/reject any tender/quotation in part or whole without assigning any reasons thereof. His decision on the dispute in any way shall be final.

In the event of an order being placed with against the tender/quotation and failure to supply equipments in accordance with the terms and conditions by acceptance of tender/quotation or to replace any items rejected by this office or any person on this behalf within such frame as may be stipulated, the Chief Medical Officer TB Control Programme Panaji shall be entitled to purchase the same from elsewhere without notice to the quotation on the account, such equipments from any other service and at such price as the Competent Authority shall at the sole discretion think fit and if such shall exceed the rate set responsible to pay the difference between the price at which such items have been purchased by this office and the price calculated at the rate set out in the schedule.
