The state of Goa is in the **Malaria Elimination phase expected to eliminate malaria by 2023**, as the API (Annual Parasite incidence is the number of positive cases per one thousand population) in both the district is less than one.

In the months of January, February and March 2023, all 34 health centers have achieved zero indigenous transmission for malaria.

The state of Goa has completed three (3) TAS (Transmission Assessment Survey) in the year 2013, 2016 & 2019 after successful implementation of 8 rounds of Mass Drug Administration (MDA) for 8 years (2004–2011) and with a coverage more than 85% and microfilaria rate <1%.

State of Goa is awaiting elimination of filarial certificate from Government of India and also award for the achievement.


